Listed below are a few of my NPF highlights from our very own Postmaster General and Chief Executive Officer Meagan Brennan.

- In her address, the Postmaster General identified strategic initiatives and investments to provide the mailing industry with greater digital capabilities. "Our vision is not confined to what we can accomplish in the next year or two. We have to continue to build and focus on the long-term rewards."
- PMG Brennan also showcased the development of Informed Delivery (previously Real-Mail Notification) a mail preview service on track to be available as a mobile app in every ZIP code across the country in early 2017.



 Finally, the Postmaster General announced that the Postal Service will file a request with the Postal Regulatory Commission this year to allow commercial customers to add the 3rd once free to mailed content beginning in January 2017.

Overall the NPF was a great experience and opportunity to gain knowledge and meet industry leaders.
